



WAFF MEMBERSHIP

Levels and Requirements

This document provides a brief summary of the levels of membership available to new applicants.

The full and official details of the WAFF Membership process are found in Article 4 detailed in Article 4 of the WAFF Statutes. If you have any questions, please contact us.

Authority - Only the WAFF Congress shall have the authority to approve a National Association for admission as a Member of the Federation.

Levels of Membership –

Full Voting Members: Open to those associations who have provided copies of:

- 1: All legal documents of registration within their own countries or
- 2: Documents of official recognition from their Ministries of Sport or other official national sports agency
- 3: Details regarding the Association's leadership including titles and contact information
- 4: A copy of its Constitution, and
- 5: Photos, videos, and / or newspaper reports documenting that the applicant is a functioning amputee football organization.

Full Voting Members may participate in all tournaments and other events to which they are invited, and have full voting rights. Full Voting Members have an annual Membership fee of USD \$500.00

Provisional Members:

Provisional Memberships are open to organizations who have not yet completed items 1 through 4 above, but who can demonstrate their activities as a sport organization.

Provisional Members may participate in WAFF competitions and other events for a period of two years while they gather their legal and other documents.

During that time Provisional Members:

- 1: May compete in WAFF competitions and other events, and
- 2: Are not required to pay membership fees
- 3: Do not yet have a vote in WAFF affairs

Application Requirements –

- Any national association applying for WAFF membership shall apply to the Federation in writing.
- The applicant Association must agree that it shall conduct itself free of any discrimination of any kind as per Article 3.1 of the WAFF Statutes.



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- The applicant association must agree to follow the Statutes, Rules, Regulations, Policies and Decisions of WAFF and its Confederations; and to play strictly according to the WAFF Laws of the Game.
- Members are required to allow and to encourage the development of teams and leagues in their countries, and that the leadership of those teams and leagues are assured an equal opportunity to rise to the Member's leadership.
- Payment of its initial membership fee must be made within 90 days of acceptance as a Full Voting Member of the association's membership by the Congress.
- Prospective Members are not required to pay a membership fee until they are accepted as Full Voting member.
